POLICY STATEMENT

Lyft Crane Hire supplies mobile cranes, operators, dogman and riggers to civil, commercial and infrastructure projects across South East Queensland. Every job we do involves a suspended load over a live worksite. A dropped load, a crane tipped on soft ground or an operator working under a powerline does not produce a minor injury — it produces a fatality.

Our objective is simple and it does not move: every worker who starts a shift with Lyft Crane Hire goes home in the same condition they arrived, and no one on the sites we work on is harmed by our crane. We hold ourselves to full compliance with the Work Health and Safety Act 2011 (Qld), the Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011 (Qld), the Mobile Crane Code of Practice, the relevant Australian Standards, and the requirements of the principal contractors we work for.

No lift proceeds until the crane is set up correctly, the load is known, the ground is right and the crew agrees it is safe. Any person on site can stop a lift, and will not be disadvantaged for doing so.

OUR COMMITMENTS

As the person conducting a business or undertaking, Lyft Crane Hire commits to:

- Providing and maintaining cranes, lifting gear and systems of work that are without risk to health and safety, so far as is reasonably practicable.
- Planning every lift before it happens — load weight verified, crane and configuration selected against the load chart, ground conditions assessed, exclusion zones set, and a lift plan or lift study prepared where the lift is complex, critical or near services.
- Eliminating hazards at the source wherever we can, and where we cannot, minimising risk by applying the hierarchy of controls.
- Preparing a Safe Work Method Statement for all high risk construction work before that work starts, and working to it. Where conditions change — wind, ground, load, adjacent works — the lift stops and the SWMS is reviewed with the crew before work resumes.
- Consulting our operators, dogman and riggers, and the principal contractor and other duty holders, on matters that affect their health and safety.
- Only putting licensed, verified competent people on our cranes, and checking those licences before a person operates or slings.
- Registering, inspecting and maintaining every crane and every item of lifting gear, and taking anything defective out of service immediately.
- Reporting, recording and investigating all incidents, injuries, near misses and dropped or shifted loads, identifying root cause and closing out corrective actions.
- Supporting the recovery and safe, durable return to work of any worker who is injured.
- Setting measurable safety objectives, monitoring performance against them, and reviewing this system at least annually.
- Providing the resources — time, money, people and plant — needed to make the above real rather than paper.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Director — holds the primary duty of care, exercises due diligence under section 27 of the WHS Act, and provides the resources and direction needed for this policy to work.

Operations Manager — plans and coordinates lifts, verifies crane selection and configuration against the load, confirms operator and dogman competency, liaises with the principal contractor, and has authority to refuse or stop a lift.

Crane operators, dogman and riggers — take reasonable care of their own health and safety and that of others, complete pre-start inspections, work to the lift plan and the SWMS, use the PPE provided, and report hazards, incidents and near misses immediately.

This policy is displayed at Lyft Crane Hire worksites and is communicated to all workers at induction.
